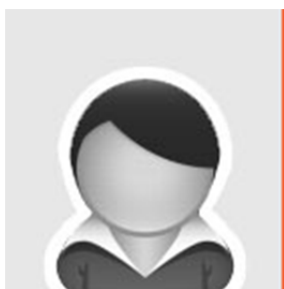

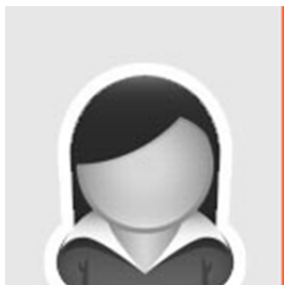


Peter Ekdahl, MBA
